Cellar Contemporary presents *Europa*, the new project by the artist David Aaron Angeli. A first body of works will be set up as a preview on April 6th 2017 at 6.30 pm, at Studio d'Arte Raffaelli - Sala Bacco, together with the opening of the solo show by the artist Matt Philips. The second and more significant part of the exhibition will be held at Cellar Contemporary and will open on May, 25th at 6.30 pm.

In David Aaron Angeli's works cultural symbols of models of ancestral societies play a key role: the artist recalls mythical stories made of naturalistic figures and elements through wax sculptures and drawings on paper. The works on show recreate the initial episode of the myth of Europa, through the themes of the journey, the discovery and the cyclicity of life.

*Born in 1982, in Santiago, Chile, David Aaron Angeli soon arrived to Trentino Alto Adige, Italy. He studied Jewelry at Istituto d'Arte Vittoria in Trento, and in 2006 he got his diploma from Accademia di Belle Arti di Brera, in Milan. He expresses his research through drawings on paper and sculptures. His drawings create big wall installations and seem to inhabit the space. The raw material for his sculptures is bee-wax. Sculptures are then painted with Indian ink or drawn near other materials, like wood, metal and glass. The artist currently lives and works in Dimaro, Trento.*
